ENHANCED CLEANING PROTOCOL

Increased number of hand sanitizer stations in key locations

Safe, effective cleaning products used on schedule throughout the day at all high touch areas in school/classroom and on bus.

Intense cleaning nightly.

COVID POSITIVE PROTOCOL

Individuals will be quarantined for 14 days before returning to school. Contact tracing will be conducted by the Hendricks County Health Department.

OTHER ILLNESSES

Students must see a provider and be fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and be symptom-free for 10 days before returning to school.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOL

1 MASKS



We protect each other by wearing masks. Wearing masks is our #1 weapon to fight this virus and keep school open. Students and staff are required to have a mask with them at all times. There will be situations when masks will be required (bus, passing period, hallway, clinics, or classroom activities where social distancing is not an option).

2 TRAINING



Professional development will be provided to all staff at start of school year on symptoms and screening measures.

3 DIVIDED CLINIC LOCATIONS



There will be an area for students displaying symptoms who are waiting to be picked up and another areas for medication distribution, etc.

4 SEATING CHARTS



Seating charts will be required on buses, in classrooms, and in the cafeteria. Siblings will be seated together on buses.

5 HAND WASHING



Hand washing will be required throughout the day. Additional hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.

6 PAPER TOWEL DISPENSERS



Dispensers will be installed in all restrooms.

7 WATER BOTTLES



Students will be allowed to carry water bottles. All water fountains will be used only for the purpose of filling water bottles.

8 NO OUTSIDE FOOD DELIVERIES



Deliveries will not be permitted into schools for students or staff during the school day.

9 STAY HOME IF SICK



Families must screen their children and keep them home if ill. Sick children will be directed immediately upon arrival to the nurse who will require him/her to be picked up if exhibiting symptoms.
