



Directions for Adding BrainPOP to Schoology

Teachers:

1. Go to Courses and create a new course or open an existing course
2. Click on "Add Materials"
3. Select "Add File/Link/External Tool" from the drop down menu
4. Select "External Tool" in the pop-up window
5. In the pop-up window, From the drop down menu next to Tool Provider select BrainPOP or BrainPOP Jr.
6. Enter BrainPOP or BrainPOP Jr. as the Title
7. Click Submit



Once the teacher adds the external tool URL and clicks an LTI link to launch BrainPOP, they will be prompted for the educator code for their school. Teachers may need to refresh the page once BrainPOP launches in Schoology.

Select "create a class"

In the **Class name** box, create a Title for your class similar to what would be listed on a school schedule.

In the **Class code** box, give your class a nickname that is unique with no spaces. This code can be given to students for enrollment into your class, so be sure to keep in mind that this code will not be private. Also, try to make it something fairly easy to remember.

Your students will join this class (e.g., Period 2 Science, Mr. Miller's Science Class).

Your students will use this class code to join the class. Your class code must have at least 6 characters and 1 number (e.g., millerbiology2, cougarsmath300).

CANCEL CREATE CLASS

Students:

When students use SSO for the first time, they will be asked if they already have a personal My BrainPOP account.

If they select "Yes, I have one" and enter it in the next step, it will connect their existing My BrainPOP account to their LMS account. Going forward they can always log in via the SSO and will not need to log in to BrainPOP manually.
