



Exporting and Importing Favorites from Web Browsers

EXPORTING:


Chrome

- Open Chrome
- In the top right corner of the browser, click the Chrome menu (3 dots) 
- Select Bookmarks, Bookmark Manager
- Click on 3 dots again
- Select Export bookmarks
- Browse to your U: drive
- Rename file to Chrome Bookmarks
- Save

Firefox


- Open Firefox
- In the top right corner of the browser, click on the Bookmarks button 
- Click on Bookmarks
- Select Show All Bookmarks
- From the toolbar, click on Import and Backup
- Select Export Bookmarks to HTML
- Browse to your U: drive
- Type a File Name
- Save

Edge



- Open Edge browser. Click the Hub icon (3 dots on upper right) 
- Click Settings to open Settings pane.
- Click the Import from another browser button.
- Now, under Import or export a file section, click the Export to file button to open Save as dialog.
- Browse to your U: drive
- Type a File Name
- Save


Chrome

- Open Chrome
- In the top right corner of the browser, click the Chrome menu (3 dots) 
- Select Bookmarks, Import Bookmarks and Settings
- Click on the drop down arrow (Microsoft Edge) and select Bookmarks HTML File
- Select Choose File
- Browse to your U: drive
- Find the file you named Chrome Bookmarks
- Open/Done

Firefox

- Open Firefox
- In the top right corner of the browser, click on the Bookmarks button  
- Click on Bookmarks
- Select Show All Bookmarks
- From the toolbar, click on Import and Backup
- Select Import Bookmarks from HTML
- Browse to your U: drive
- Find the file you named Firefox Bookmarks
- Open

Edge

- Open Edge browser
- Click the Hub icon (3 dots on upper right)  
- Click Settings to open Settings pane.
- Under the Import or export a file menu – choose Import from file.
- Browse to your U: drive
- Find the file you named Edge Bookmarks
- Open
