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Your child is exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19. We understand your concerns about COVID-19 and we also hope that every child can attend school safely. In order to minimize the spread of COVID in the community, individuals with any of the COVID symptoms listed below need to stay home in accordance with ISDH guidelines. We encourage you to contact your primary care provider, testing results may determine when your child can return to school. Please note, if your child has been deemed a close-contact of an individual with COVID a negative test does not eliminate their quarantine. If your child is tested for COVID-19 you should keep any siblings home until those results come back negative.
