

The site starts recording right away, so be ready! Once you're done, or if you mess up, click "stop." From here you can listen to what you've recorded or re-try.

Once you're satisfied with your recording, click here at the bottom of the screen:

Now you have a link for your recording! The only "downside" to Vocaroo is that if you lose this link, you lose your recording. My advice is to email the link to yourself so you always have it.






**#2 Audacity** – a software program...school computers definitely have it, but I don't know about your own laptops?


When Audacity is opened, it looks like this.

The recording part is easy – simply press the record button  and speak. Press the play button to listen to what you have. If you're not happy with it, simply record over.


The trickier part is saving to a file that any computer can open. **Click FILE, then EXPORT.** You'll get a window that looks like this:



You can fill out this information if you want, but it's not necessary.

Don't do anything else – click “OK.”

Do not just save where the window defaults – choose your English 12 folder, and decide on a name to call it. Like so...




IMPORTANT – the file should be a WAV file. It should default to this, but if not, choose WAV from the dropdown menu.

Now you can attach your file to an email! 😊




Click "Allow" for your mic and webcam to be recognized




Record your podcast
