

## General Classroom Information Nutrition and Wellness

### GRADES:

1. Grades—we will use the school’s standard grading scale.
  - Semester Grading System is based on a continuous grade and treats the 1<sup>st</sup> nine weeks’ grade as a midterm report.
  - Final Exam counts as 1/7 of your Semester grade.
2. Individual assignments will be graded by points.
3. Most daily or workbook assignments will count 1 point per answer. Class work is 45% of your final grade.
4. Tests will be graded by points. Test count 25% of your final grade
5. In-class assignments and class projects (such as collages, posters, unit plans, etc.) **must be completed IN CLASS**. Special reports and assignments will be graded according to guidelines given at the time of the assignment.
6. Lab grades will equal about 50pts. Lab grades count 30% of your final grade. **Excused absences** from lab may be made up, but will not include participation points. For example, for a “make up” Foods Lab the maximum points you may earn are 45/50. Some labs can be made up at school during SRT or may be made up at home but the proper form must be filled out and signed by a parent to get your points. **Missed Labs must be made up within 1 week after absence.**
8. Sometimes as a teaching tool it is beneficial to trade and grade papers in class. If a student is sensitive about doing this method, they may talk to the teacher and we will work together to make other arrangements.
9. PARENT ACCESS—If you are absent on the day a test is given or an assignment is collected and graded, your grade will go into the computer as a “0” until the assignment is made-up and graded. You and your parents need to be aware of this practice and react accordingly. It is YOUR responsibility to ask for make-up work.

TESTS AND QUIZZES: These are department property and will not be returned for you to keep. We will keep them until the end of the trimester. Tests and Quizzes will be returned for the student to review but will be returned to the teacher. Parents may come into school to see any test or quiz.

BOOKS, WORKBOOKS AND SUPPLIES: These should be brought to class daily. Repeated failure to do so may result in an after school detention.

**Supplies Needed: Textbook and workbook, pen and pencil. A positive attitude and willingness to try and experience new things is what I expect.**
